To operate a school bus, you will require a class 2BE driver's license. If you do not currently have a class 2BE license, we provide all required training to help you obtain one. The process involves:

Complete a 5-day training course (August 5-9, 2024), obtain a clean criminal record check, vulnerable sector check, a drivers abstract, a vision test, a written test, and a road test. Once a 2BE license is obtained, we provide paid behind the wheel training, and reimbursement for most licensing costs.
