TIMELINE

2017 - 2018 - A team of teachers from three ASD-N Schools received high level professional learning on Personalization in an effort to make a shift towards becoming Personalized Schools.

2018 - 2019 - Three schools implemented innovative new approaches to teaching and learning. Two additional schools received similar professional learning and immediately began implementing changes.

2019 - 2020 - Additional schools will be chosen to become Personalized Schools and will receive high level professional learning and district support to implement Personalization. Existing schools will continue to receive support. \$1500 personalization grants introduced.

2021 - Future - More schools will receive high level professional learning and ongoing district support to help make the shift towards Personalization.
